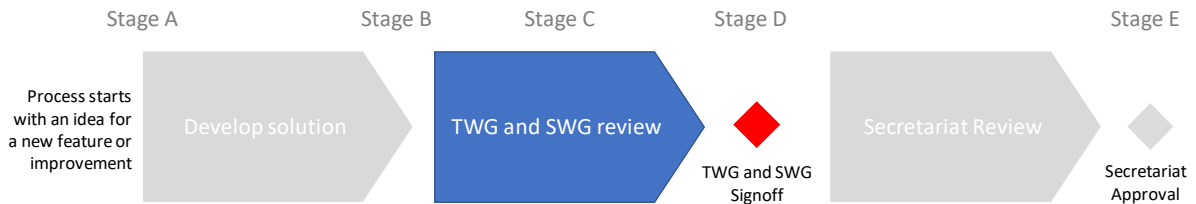


SDMX 3.0 Delivery Project

Feature Solution Design Review and Approval Process

Guidance for TWG and SWG Reviewers

The new features and changes planned for version 3.0 of the standard are developed by the TWG Task Forces, but the solution designs they propose need to be reviewed and endorsed by the TWG and SWG membership before going to the Secretariat for approval – Stage C and D below.



How does the review process work?

Solution Designs will be emailed for review

- When a good solution has been developed by the Task Force for one of the planned features or changes, details will be emailed out to the TWG and SWG membership for review and comment.

One week to review – submit comments verbally or by email

- Reviewers have about **one week** to respond with any comments – a deadline for comments will be given.
- There are two ways to comment:
 - (1) Verbally by attending a **Webex** teleconference which will be held on the date of the comment deadline; or
 - (2) In writing by emailing the relevant TWG Task Force leader.
- Reviewers only need to attend the Webex teleconference if they want to make verbal comments or to discuss the solution.

Assumed acceptance

- The review process assumes that each TWG and SWG member endorses the solution proposed for a particular feature, unless they explicitly submit comments.
